United Overseas Bank Limited (UOB) is committed to environmental protection by reducing our operational carbon emissions and impacts across the locations where we operate, complying with applicable environmental and/or sustainability-related regulations.

Our environmental management practices include:

- establishing and achieving our operational decarbonisation targets and roadmaps, covering energy consumption, waste management, greenhouse gas emissions (Scope 1, Scope 2 and relevant Scope 3), and consistently monitoring our performance;
- reducing the consumption of resources, including energy and water, and reducing waste generated;
- promoting the use of energy-efficient and water-efficient solutions, technologies, products and services, through enhancing environmental awareness among our colleagues, customers and visitors;
- implementing green/sustainable features, solutions and technologies into the design and retrofitting of our real estate assets, including buildings and branches;
- achieving and maintaining industry-recognised green building certifications for our wholly-owned/strategic buildings and selected branches and offices;
- engaging relevant stakeholders, including suppliers and service providers, on environmental issues and seeking their support to enhance our operational environmental performance;
- reviewing operational processes periodically, with the aim of identifying potential gaps and implementing relevant corrective actions;
- identifying, assessing, mitigating and adapting climate-related physical risks (e.g. flooding) for our buildings, offices and branches;
- collecting accurate and reliable data on our operational environmental performance indicators, including energy consumption, water use, waste generation, paper usage and greenhouse gas emissions, for regular tracking and reporting; and
- reporting our operational environmental performance regularly in the UOB Sustainability Report, which is approved by the UOB Board and Management.
